

# Understanding Winnebago County's COVID-19 Vaccination Process

**There is limited supply of vaccine and resources for vaccination.**

**Our vaccination process may not be the same as other counties.**

**You may need to wait a while for your turn, but we will get to you.**

**As our community moves toward vaccinating Phase 1b, remember, Phase 1b is a large group that includes frontline essential workers (*law enforcement, teachers, public transit and more*) and those over 65.**

## We Ask That You:

- **Be Patient**
  - It will take time to vaccinate those in each phase and most will not be vaccinated right away.
- **Wait for your turn.**
  - It is not first come first serve. There are many factors considered when deciding vaccination order.
- **Understand there is no timeline.**
  - How fast we are able to move through the phases will be dependent on supplies, resources and number of individuals in each phase.
