Trustee Wright stated he has received several calls about Lismore Road in Crystal Hills. Residents are complaining about the speeding on the street and a need for a stop sign half way. Brandon stated essentially that a stop sign is not warranted in that location per IDOT. There are no track records, restricted views or vehicular traffic volume. There are no warrants for this location, per Illinois Code, Roscoe can put stop signs where they want. However, it is up to the board, police to see if it is warranted. Chief Hawley stated Lismore is patrolled all the time, he doesn't believe a stop sign will help with that issue. Trustee Wright stated Chicory Ridge has so many stop signs, to which Attorney Kurlinkas stated that was decided by the board to have stop signs at every intersection. Trustee Wright stated it's a long stretch of road, President Gustafson asked where would you want the stop sign to be? Trustee Wright stated kids play on the street because of the railroad tracks. Brandon stated he would look into this and address at next meeting.
