MINUTES of REGULAR MEETING of APRIL 19, 2023

The April 19, 2023 Regular Meeting of the Village of Roscoe Board of Fire and Police Commissioners convened at 6:30 p.m. Chairman LeAnn Jones, Commissioner Mark Nytko, Commissioner David Jacobson, Attorney Chuck Kostantacos, Chief Sam Hawley, Deputy Chief Thomas Farone and Secretary Victoria Eggers were present.

Chairman LeAnn Jones called the meeting to order at 6:32 p.m. The roll was called for the record: Chairman LeAnn Jones, Commissioner Mark Nytko and Commissioner David Jacobson were present. There was a quorum.

MINUTES

The Minutes from the Regular Meeting of April 5, 2023 were reviewed and discussed. Being as there were no suggested corrections, the Minutes were approved as drafted and distributed on motion by Commissioner Jacobson. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Nytko, followed by a unanimous vote to approve the Minutes.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

The Commissioners reviewed and discussed the psychological evaluations and medical exam results of two potential initial hire candidates.

After the review and discussion, Commissioner Nytko made a motion to accept the results of Brian Freeman's psychological evaluation and medical exam. Commissioner Jacobson seconded the motion, followed by unanimous vote to accept the results.

Commissioner Jacobson made a motion to accept the results of Ania Podgorny's psychological evaluation and medical exam. Commissioner Nytko seconded the motion, followed by unanimous vote to accept the results.

Commissioner Jacobson made a motion to appoint Brian Freeman as a probationary, full-time Patrol Officer, subject to all applicable rules and regulations of the Village of Roscoe Fire and Police Commission and the Village of Roscoe Police Department. Commissioner Nytko seconded the motion, followed by unanimous vote to appoint Brian Freeman as a probationary, full-time Patrol Officer.

Commissioner Nytko made a motion to appoint Ania Podgorny as a probationary, full-time Patrol Officer, subject to all applicable rules and regulations of the Village of Roscoe Fire and Police Commission and the Village of Roscoe Police Department. Commissioner Jacobson seconded the motion, followed by unanimous vote to appoint Ania Podgorny as a probationary, full-time Patrol Officer.

Chief Hawley called Brian Freeman and Ania Podgorny to offer them probationary, full-time Patrol Officer positions. Each of them accepted the offer. Chief Hawley told Brian and Ania that someone would be in contact with them to set up a time to sign paperwork and to give them more information.

The Commissioners discussed the next lateral hire process. Attorney Kostantacos placed an ad for lateral hire applicants. The deadline to apply will be May 1, 2023. If there are any applicants and if they meet all the requirements, interviews will be scheduled before the May 3, 2023 meeting.

NEW BUSINESS

There was a brief discussion in reference to the Rules and Regulations regarding the probationary period of full-time officers. There will be more discussion and possible action at the next meeting.

BILLS

Attorney Kostantacos submitted an invoice in the amount of \$868.75 for his services in March 2023. Commissioner Nytko moved to pay the bill. Commissioner Jacobson seconded the motion, followed by unanimous vote to approve paying the \$868.75 bill.

Glenwood Center submitted an invoice for \$900.00 for two pre-employment evaluations. Commissioner Jacobson made a motion to approve paying the bill. Commissioner Nytko seconded the motion, followed by unanimous vote to approve paying the \$900.00 bill.
