MINUTES of REGULAR MEETING of MARCH 20, 2024

The March 20, 2024 Regular Meeting of the Village of Roscoe Board of Fire and Police Commissioners convened at 5:30 p.m. Board Chair LeAnn Jones, Commissioner Mark Nytko, Commissioner David Jacobson, Deputy Chief Tom Farone, Attorney Chuck Kostantacos and Secretary to the Board Victoria Eggers were present.

Board Chair LeAnn Jones called the meeting to order at 5:33 p.m. The roll was called for the record: Board Chair LeAnn Jones, Commissioner Mark Nytko and Commissioner David Jacobson were present. There was a quorum.

MINUTES

The Regular Meeting Minutes of March 6, 2024 were reviewed and discussed. Being as there were no suggested corrections, the Minutes were approved as drafted and distributed on motion by Commissioner Nytko. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Jacobson, followed by unanimous vote to approve the Minutes.

The Special Meeting Minutes of March 9, 2024 were reviewed and discussed. Being as there were no suggested corrections, the Minutes were approved as drafted and distributed on motion by Commissioner Jacobson. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Nytko, followed by unanimous vote to approve the Minutes.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

There was a brief discussion on the preference claim made by Anthony Bowersock. Board Chair Jones asked Attorney Kostantacos if what was submitted was sufficient for the claim, and he answered that it was sufficient.

Based upon the discussion, Commissioner Jacobson made a motion to award five (5) preference points to Anthony Bowersock. Commissioner Nytko seconded the motion, followed by unanimous vote to approve awarding Anthony Bowersock five (5) preference points.

Once the preference points were awarded, Commissioner Nytko made a motion to merge the existing Eligibility List for Patrol Officer with the new list and adopt the merged Eligibility List for Patrol Officer calculated with allowable preference points. Commissioner Jacobson seconded the motion, followed by unanimous vote to merge and adopt the two lists.

The Commissioners independently reviewed background reports for multiple candidates.

After the discussion, Commissioner Nytko moved to accept the background report for Anthony Tirado. Commissioner Jacobson seconded the motion, followed by unanimous vote to accept Anthony Tirado's background report.

Once the background report was accepted, Commissioner Jacobson moved to make a conditional offer of probationary, full-time employment as a Patrol Officer to Anthony Tirado, subject to all applicable rules and regulations of the Village of Roscoe Board of Fire and Police Commissioners as well as the Village of Roscoe Police Department, including but not limited to passing a psychological exam, drug screen and a medical exam. Commissioner Nytko seconded the motion, followed by unanimous vote to make a conditional offer of probationary, full-time employment to Anthony Tirado.

Commissioner Nytko made a motion to accept Tristan Linthakhanh's background report. Commissioner Jacobson seconded the motion, followed by a unanimous vote to accept the background report for Tristan Linthakhanh.

Once the background report was accepted, Commissioner Jacobson moved to make a conditional offer of probationary, full-time employment as a Patrol Officer to Tristan Linthakhanh, subject to all applicable rules and regulations of the Village of Roscoe Board of Fire and Police Commissioners as well as the Village of Roscoe Police Department, including but not limited to passing a psychological exam, drug screen and a medical exam. Commissioner Nytko seconded the motion, followed by a unanimous vote to make a conditional offer of probationary, full-time employment to Tristan Linthakhanh.

Deputy Chief Farone called Anthony Tirado and then Tristan Linthakhanh to formally offer each of them conditional offers of employment. Both Anthony Tirado and Tristan Linthakhanh accepted the offers and agreed to go to the Police Department and sign the required documents.


